
Title IV, Part A Funding Application





- Only one reform budget tag per budget item
 - Well-rounded
 - Safe and Healthy
 - Effective Use of Technology
- Reform budget tags are required







- Title IV, Part A allocation with \$30,000 or more require at least 20% for well-rounded, 20% for safe and healthy, and a portion for effective use of technology (15% Technology Infrastructure limit)
- Category of spending is still required even if the amount is less than \$30,000 **after** transfer to cost pool.

Example: Title IV, Part A Allocation - \$30,100

Transfer to Cost Pool - \$500

Remaining - \$29,600

\$6,020 is the minimum requirement for 20% spending on well-rounded and safe and healthy


