






**CSPR Title IV-A Survey** 



The Consolidated State Performance Report (CSPR) is the required annual reporting tool for each State under Section 8303[1] of the *Elementary and Secondary Education Act* (ESEA), as amended by the *Every Student Succeeds Act of* 2015(ESSA)[2].


