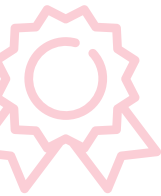
VISION



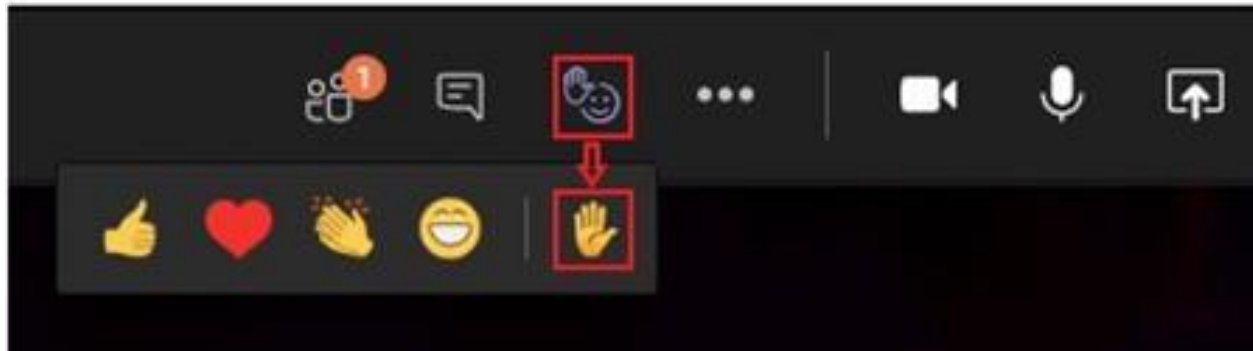

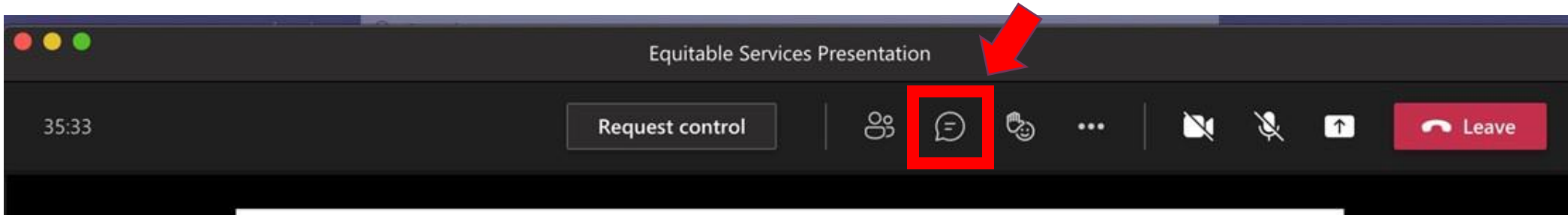
